



Design the Social Inclusion Action Plan 2016-2020 for the Municipality of Durrës

The goal

Under the supervision of the UNDP Programme Analyst for Social Inclusion, and the direct supervision of the National Programme Coordinator for the UNSSIA Programme and with the overall guidance of the Ministry of Social Welfare and Youth and the Municipality of Durrës, the team experts of Urban Research Institute will be responsible for assisting the municipality of Durres in designing the Social Inclusion Action Plan for the period 2016 -2020.

Description of the methodology

The overall objective of the SIPD is to achieve a balanced and sustainable framework for ensuring that social inclusion is measured, monitored and reported in Albania through a robust set of indicators thereby improving ways in which social inclusion is linked to improving Government policies and Albania's progress towards EU accession. The monitoring and measurement of social inclusion will cover six policy domains, including: poverty and social protection; employment and skills; health; education and training; basic needs; and participation and human rights.



Expected products

The team of experts is responsible for:

- Assessing existing evidence and indicators used in the six policy domains established in the SIPD
- Assessing the needs of local authorities and other community actors
- Assessing the communication strategy of the municipality in terms of social inclusion
- Developing the Municipal Plan for Social Inclusion based on the information generated from the Assessment Phase.
