

BENEFICIARY ASSESSMENT OF THE WORLD BANK COMMUNITY WORKS PROGRAM, MANAGED BY ALBANIAN DEVELOPMENT FUND

The assignment includes development and implementation of an evaluation methodology for the assessment of benefits out of the implementation of infrastructure projects financed by Albanian Development Fund under World Bank funding. The assessment was developed through combination of several methodologies including survey, focus groups of benefiting community and interviews with local elected officials and central government agencies.

The survey involved a sample of 1,200 local and central government officials, community representatives, private construction companies and private designing bureaus, spread out in 22 local government units benefiting 42 infrastructure sub-projects.

URI was solely in charge to design survey instruments, conduct field operations, administer data and report findings. The assignment includes organization and delivery of a National Conference held in Tirana on June 2002 to publish main findings of the beneficiary assessment activity.
