

Implementation of integrated local waste planning in Lezha municipality

Context

Dldp contribution in the sector of waste management during 2016 was mainly focused on sectorial planning and developing an instrument such as performance based service delivery which will lead to the definition of minimum affordable standards.

During 2016 dldp and URI supported Lezha municipality to draft the local waste management plan, as well as to prepare the tender documents for, outsourcing the service.

Purpose and objective of the project in 2017

The purpose of the project is to support Lezha Municipality to implement integrated local waste management plan, in order to improve the financial management and thus economic sustainability of the sector. The project is focused in 3 main pillars:

- **Monitoring of the service**
- **Revenue collection**
- **Public information/communication**

Learnings derived from the implementation of activities in these three pillars will be used to review the curricula on service monitoring and implementation for Lezha Municipality.

Beneficiaries of the project

Main beneficiaries of the project is the Municipality of Lezha and the habitants of this municipality who will be served with a better service.



Activities

The following activities are part of the project following each main pillar:

- Monitoring of the waste management service delivery.

The establishment and the preparation of organigram and ToR for each member of the Monitoring Working Group. Assisting the monitoring and evaluation group to perform the monitoring process based on the monitoring and evaluation plan.

- Revenue Collection

Preparation and design of a billing model which will be delivered to the consumers, review of the current database of the clients and assistance in consolidating this database. Assisting the municipality in developing and improving municipal regulations on database update and debts and penalties.

- Public Information

Preparation of communication strategy on waste management service and follow-up of communication to public.

Preparation of a check list of channels of communication for waste management service and tariff that include

- Public Information

Capacity building for the municipal officials on waste management service delivery through trainings and follow up of the process.
